

EXPLANATION OF JOB PLACEMENT CALCULATION

ACCSC

Employment Rate: The school's official rate of graduate job attainment for each cohort and for the program for the reporting period. The school's official rate of employment is that which is used to determine compliance with accreditation requirements. The rate is determined by dividing graduates employed in the field by graduates available for employment.

Graduates Employed in the Field: The number of graduates employed in jobs for which the program trained them.

Graduates Available for Employment: The total number of students available for employment, this number is determined by subtracting the number of Graduates Unavailable for Employment from the total number of graduates.

Graduates Unavailable for Employment: This category removes from the graduation rate calculation graduates who fall into one of the following categories: death, incarceration, active military service deployment, the onset of a medical condition that prevents employment, or international students who have returned to their country of origin.

Completions: All students who completed a program.

Placed Related: The number of students who completed a program during the reporting period, who were employed in a job following graduation that was directly related to their program of instruction at the school.

Placed Unrelated: The number of students who completed a program during the reporting period, who were employed in a job following graduation that was NOT directly related to the program of instruction at the school.

Not Placed: Students who were seeking employment, but were not employed following graduation.

Not Available for Placement: The number of students who, for whatever reason, are unavailable for placement. These could be students who are already employed due to medical or other personal reasons are not seeking placement. Also, this number could include students who have failed to report their placement status to the school.
